## Other Loan Forgiveness Programs

In addition to all these program-specific options, federal entities, and national organizations, your state or school might offer service-based programs that cancel, reduce, or repay part of your student loans.

Some examples include:

Contact your state agency for postsecondary education to see what programs are available in your region. You can also find this information at [www.studentaid.ed.gov](http://www.studentaid.ed.gov). At the site, click on the "Funding" tab, then go to "State Aid." Also check out loan forgiveness programs that may be available to you through trade groups, religious, civil, or professional organizations with which you are affiliated.
